**Rainforest Camouflage**

- Living things can be grouped on the basis of observable features and distinguished from non-living things (BIOLOGICAL Year 3 ACSSU044)
- Living things have structural features and adaptations that help them to survive in their environment. (BIOLOGICAL Year 5 ACSSU043) – PC: Desert Survivors and/or QCAA: Adaptations



**Butterfly Life Cycle<sup>EY</sup>**

- Living things grow, change and have offspring similar to themselves. (BIOLOGICAL Year 2 ACSSU030)
- Living things have life cycles. (BIOLOGICAL Year 4 ACSSU072)









**Forces**

- Forces can be exerted by one object on another through direct contact or from a distance. (PHYSICAL Year 4 ACSSU076) – PC: Magnetic Moves / Smooth Moves and/or QCAA: The Force of Friction
- Change to an object's motion is caused by unbalanced forces, including Earth's gravitational attraction, acting on the object. (PHYSICAL Year 7 ACSSU117)
